What is Phonics?

- Knowledge of alphabetical code
- Identifying sounds in words
- Recognising common spellings of each phoneme
- Blending phonemes in reading
- Segmenting phonemes in spelling

Definitions

- Phoneme
 - Smallest unit of sound in a word

c-a-t

c a t



Definitions

- Grapheme
 - Letters that represent the phoneme
 - Could be 1 letter, 2 letters or more

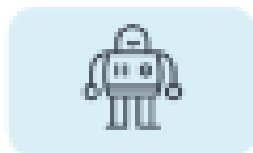
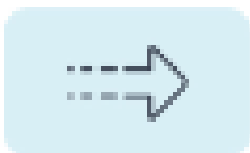
- Digraph
 - 2 letters making a sound **ai**, **ee**, **oo**
- Tri-graph
 - 3 letters making one sound
igh, **air**, **ear**

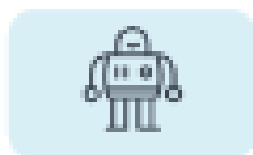
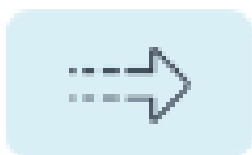
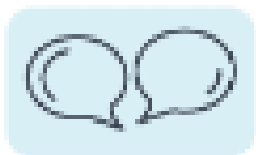
- Blending (for reading)
 - Recognising the letter sounds in a written word (c-u-p, sh-ee-p)
 - Merging them in the correct order to pronounce the word
 - Robot arms/ stretch the word

Definitions

- Segmenting (for spelling)
 - Identifying individual sounds in a spoken word s-t-or-k
 - writing down letters for each sound (phoneme) to form the word.

The Year 1 Phonics Screening Test

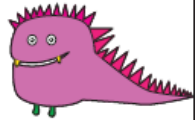
- Tests phonics **not understanding** or reading in context
- Sealed papers from Dept of Education
- Take place wk2 com **12th of June 2022** (2nd week back!)
- 1:1 with teacher
- No guidance or support given by teacher.
- Department for Education will set pass mark after tests are carried out.
- Previous pass mark **32/40**
- May not pass – not ready, focused, confused, ill etc-
-**Retake in Y2 if needed.**

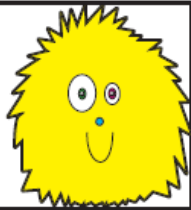

Some children blend the word k e b but then do not say what the word is. This is then incorrect.

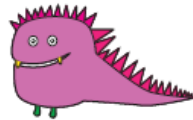

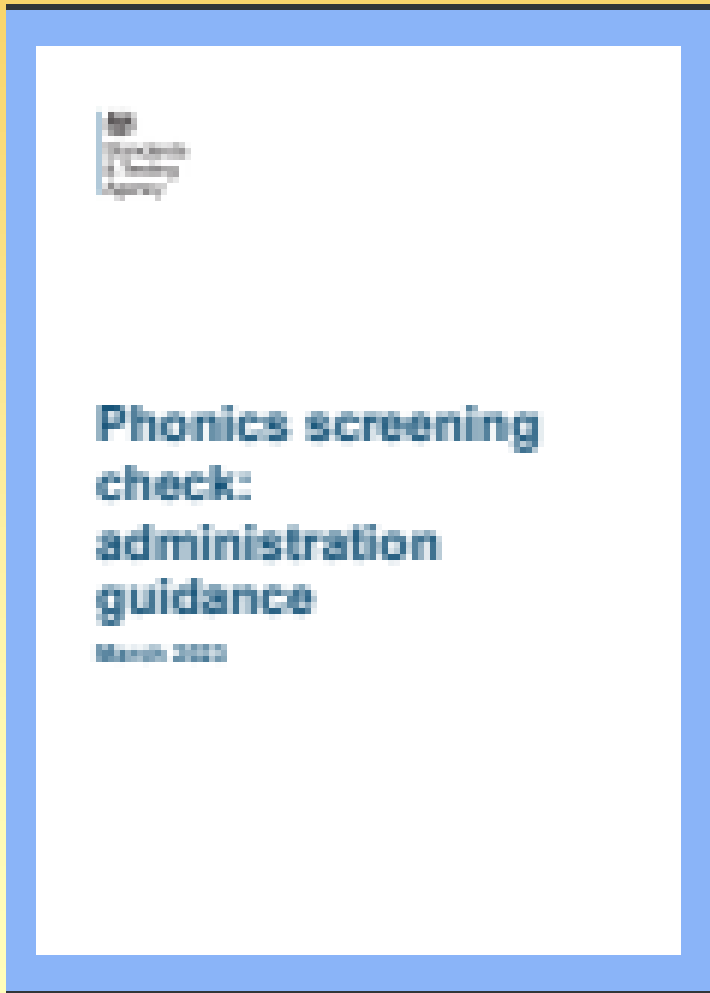

The Year 1 Phonics Screening Test



Can have a school **monitoring visit** to check we are administering the test accurately.

If a pupil is absent during the check week, we can administer the check to them until Friday 23 June.

Children with SEN needs may be except from the screener or need extra provision.

Guidelines

























- If a pupil sounds out the phonemes but does not blend the word, it must score as incorrect.
- Pupils may elongate phonemes but if they leave gaps between phonemes and do not blend them, it is incorrect.
- Alternative pronunciations of graphemes in pseudo-words can be accepted but for real words the pronunciation must be correct e.g. snow.
- A pupil's accent can be taken into consideration when deciding whether a response is acceptable.
- Pupils with pronunciation difficulties could have answers as acceptable — for example, a pupil unable to form the 'th' sound who instead usually says 'f' should have this scored as correct.

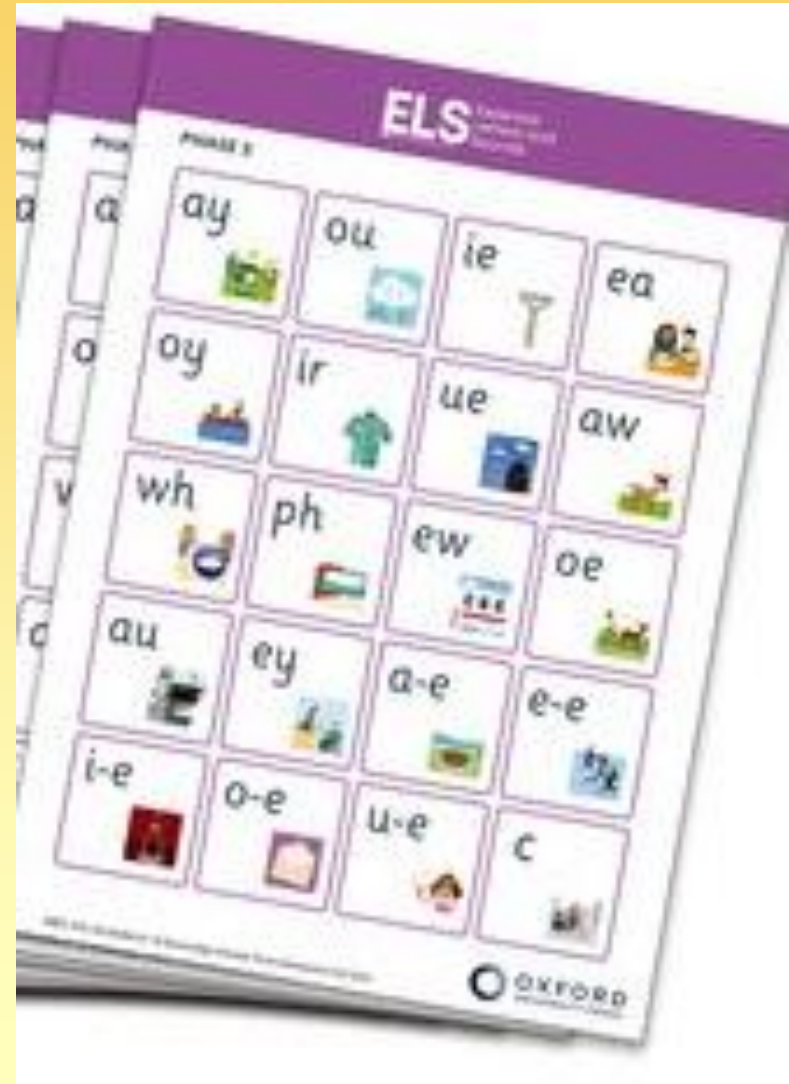
- During Phase 4, no new phonemes are introduced. Working on blending CCVC words such as **pond** or compound words such as **rainfall**.

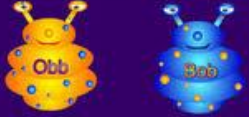
