










Idle CE(A) Primary School Summer Homework Menu Year 1

Our theme is cross-curricular and we would like children to complete one of the tasks to complement their learning in class.

<p>Research and write about your favourite animal. Can you describe the animal using adjectives?</p> 	<p>Practice counting forwards and backwards in 2s, 5s and 10s. You could count pairs of socks or shoes to help you count in 2s!</p> 	<p>Go for a spring time walk. Record. draw or take pictures of all the changes you notice.</p> 
 <p>With an adult, design and make a fruit salad. Can you add a fruit you've never tried before? Can you write a set of instructions to make your fruit salad?</p>	<p>Ask a parent or a grandparent about a place they visited when they were little like you. Where did they go? How did they get there?</p> 	<p>Use a map to find some of your favourite places to visit. This could be a city you've been to or even a different country!</p> 
<p>Sketch or photograph something you see in spring and summer. This could be plant that's grown, an animal you've spotted or even a beautiful landscape.</p> 	<p>With an adult, research and listen to Music from another country. How is this type of music different? How does it make you feel?</p> 	 <p>Make an obstacle course with directions to lead somebody around it. Try use North, East, South, West compass directions or Left and Right.</p>
